We recognize the need to stay flexible as schools across the country may continue to be impacted by pandemic-related restrictions, but we appreciate your commitment and persistence.

We are thankful to each of you and to God for the amazing ways that Kids Hope USA mentoring has transformed the lives of so many students and volunteers since 1995. 
